




Lausanne is the capital of the Swiss canton of Vaud and sits at the Northernmost point of Lake Geneva. It has a compact city centre which is steeped in history and culture, but the student population keeps Lausanne current and vibrant, with theatres, the arts, and nightlife on a par with the most beautiful European capitals.

Given its perfect harmony with nature, it will be no surprise that Lausanne is one of Europe's greenest cities with lots of wonderful parks to explore. There is a harmony of architecture as well, with the historic town called "La Cité" and a must-see gothic cathedral (often considered the most beautiful example in Switzerland), as well as a dynamic metropolis with trendy modern districts such as "Le Flon".

Lausanne has been built on 3 hills, so be sure to pack comfortable shoes as you will get a good workout walking around and exploring the city. To help you out the city is all linked by handy bridges as well as the handy Metro M2- the only metro in Switzerland.

A city in the countryside – embedded in nature and closely surrounded by the vineyards which reflect the diversity of Switzerland's wine regions. The combined forces of glaciers, rivers and mountains have produced diverse soil types and this enormous diversity is reflected in the great number of subtle nuances in the bouquets of the local wines.


